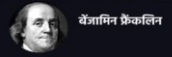

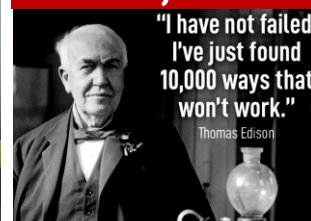

Days Celebration Brings Color, Talent, and Fun to Mahavir Polytechnic!



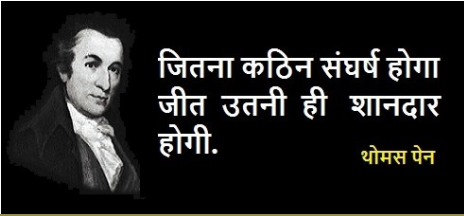
