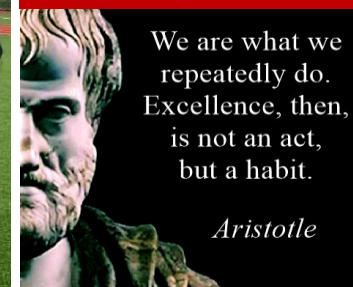

## *Electrical Engineering Department organized Industrial Visit to Banganga Paper Mills Limited*



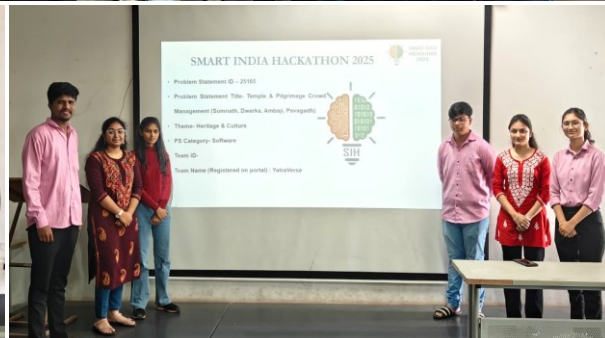
The Department of Electrical Engineering organized an industrial visit on 25 Sept. for SE and BE students to Banganga Paper Mills Limited, located at Ramshej (Ashewadi), Dindori, Nashik. The visit was arranged as part of the subject Advanced Control System and was successfully managed and coordinated by HOD Prof. A. G. Bhagwat. During the visit, students gained practical exposure to large-scale industrial operations and control systems implemented in the paper manufacturing process. Banganga Paper Mills, established in 2013, operates with an installed production capacity of over 100 metric tonnes per day and is spread across 10,000 sq. meters. The firm is known for producing a wide range of paper, board, and pulp products, including writing and printing paper, tissue paper, cardboard, corrugated boards, and stationery items. The technical team at the plant demonstrated its advanced process design, where 90–95% of water and

-chemicals are reused, minimizing fresh water consumption and promoting sustainability. Students also observed continuous production operations, advanced automation, and maintenance practices. The visit provided valuable insights into industrial-scale process control, efficiency, and environmental responsibility, bridging the gap between classroom learning and real-world applications.

## *Sanghavi College of Engineering Hosts Internal Hackathon for 'Smart India Hackathon 2025'*



The Department of Computer Engineering at Sanghavi College of Engineering, Nashik, organized an Internal Hackathon on 23rd September 2025 in the Computer Seminar Hall, as a preparatory round for the Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2025. Department of Mechanical Engineering organized an industrial visit for Second Year Mechanical Engineering (SYME) students to the Kadwa Sugar Factory at Rajaramnagar (Materewadi), Nashik recently. Guided by Mr. Balasaheb P. Ugale, Director of factory, the visit aimed to provide students with practical exposure to the working of boilers, thermal systems, sensors, automation, and mechanical equipment used in sugar manufacturing. Students observed the complete boiler system including furnace, steam drum, economizer, and superheater, along with the role of temperature, pressure, and level sensors in maintaining safety and efficiency. Other equipment such as crushers, clarifiers, evaporators, centrifuges, and the fully automated sugar packing system were demonstrated, highlighting the integration of mechanical-

-operations, chemical processes, and automation in industrial practice. The visit helped students connect classroom learning with real-world applications by providing insights into steam generation, juice clarification, energy-efficient use of bagasse as fuel, and automated production processes. Emphasis was placed on quality control, safety, and sustainable practices. Observing the entire workflow of the factory, from sugarcane crushing to crystallization and packing, enhanced students' understanding of modern industrial operations and interdisciplinary engineering applications. The visit proved highly informative and motivating, encouraging students to explore careers in mechanical engineering, process management, and industrial automation, while bridging the gap between theory and practical knowledge.
